ABSTRACT

Abd. Mutholib Dalimunthe "The Duties and Powers of the Head of Region in the Implementation of Local Government Viewed from the Perspective of Regional Government Affairs in DKI Jakarta and West Java Provinces". The problems discussed in this dissertation are: First, why is it necessary to carry out the duties and authority of the regional head in the Provinces of DKI Jakarta and West Java Province in the implementation of regional government affairs according to the principles of regional autonomy? Second, What are the factors that hamper the implementation of duties and authority of regional heads in the Provinces of DKI Jakarta and West Java Province in the implementation of local government in terms of the perspective of local government affairs?

This paper is based on the construction of the Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia Year 1945, the implementation of government within the unitary state of Indonesia is divided into provinces and provinces subdivided into districts and cities. The existence of each local government has been regulated by the Act applies aimed at accelerating development in realizing prosperity for the community.

In order to discuss the problem, the theoretical basis of the authors use is, Theory of Law Country, Decentralization Theory, Authority Theory, Theory of Regional Autonomy, Government Affairs, Principles of Implementation of Regional Autonomy, Implementation of Regional Government, and Head of Region in System of State Government.

This research was conducted with a normative juridical approach. Normative juridical is done by examining library materials and secondary data. With reference to Law Number 23 Year 2014 on Regional Government.

The result of the research is the implementation of duties and authority of the regional head in the implementation of local government affairs lies in the difference between the principle of centralization and the principle of decentralization lies in the authority to decide on the issue of state affairs as well as among the existing positions. The authority to regulate and manage government affairs is not solely done by the central government, but also by lower levels of government, both in territorial and functional units.

From the results of the study it can be concluded that the implementation of duties and authority of regional heads according to the principles of regional autonomy express essentially two main ideas, namely the idea that the people should play a role of self-determination of the idea that democratic governance must be a limited government, where equality and exist A guarantee of certain results.
