Background of the problem, as the last bastion for justice seekers, the integrity of judges is a guarantee of public trust in the judiciary, while the competence of judges is the main capital for the birth of quality court decisions, which are not only able to solve the problems faced by parties concerned, but also contributes positively to the development of national law. Both become fundamental prerequisites to achieve the objectives of the administration of justice, namely the establishment of law and justice.

The still rampant operation of hands that befell the judiciary as evidence of the still many abuses of authority and judicial corruption due to the weakness of the surveillance system is still there. This condition triggers the growth and development of acts of abuse of power that makes judicial corruption difficult to eradicate, therefore one way is to strengthen the oversight function of both the system and its personnel. The formulation of the problems investigated are 1) How is the supervision system at the Supreme Court judiciary, 2) How to implement the supervision information system at the Supreme Court judiciary, 3) How is the electronic early supervision system updated at the Supreme Court judiciary.

This research method uses an empirical juridical approach with descriptive specifications sourced from primary and secondary data. Primary data obtained through interviews and observations while secondary data obtained by means of literature study. The data that has been collected is analyzed by qualitative analysis, which is based on theory and positive legal provisions. Based on the research conducted, the results were obtained in the form of an electronic early supervision system update model at the Supreme Court judiciary by integrating the existing Supervision Information System at the Supervisory Agency with the Supreme Court Case Tracking Information System,
