Azis Budianto, SH., MS, as the Director of Promotions. On the basis of the Advocate profession is one of the noble professions, especially in a legal process. In the process of law enforcement, advocates have an active role in upholding genuine laws, namely as desired by law. The Advocate's profession in carrying out the duties has a fairly wide scope, an advocate, can accompany, consult, defend his client both in or out of court or litigation and non-litigation to settle legal cases. For legal certainty, the implementation of an advocate's duties is regulated in laws and regulations, namely Law Number 13 of 2013 concerning Advocates. In the law advocates are included as Chess of Prevention of Law Enforcement namely Police, prosecutors, Judges and Advocates. The meaning of an advocate is one of the law enforcers in Indonesia who has an equal position with the Police, Prosecutors and Judges in the role of an ongoing legal process. The difference is that the Police, Prosecutors and Judges obtain income from the State, while the Advocates get income from the results of their purchases or purchases from their Clients. In carrying out their duties, advocates on the one hand must uphold the law correctly, on the other hand they must defend their clients who have problems with the law to earn income. In the law of advocacy freedom and the right of immunity in carrying out its duties, as reflected in Article 5 and Article 16 of Law Number 18 Year 2013 concerning Advocates. Related to this right of immunity, it cannot be interpreted in general, therefore the implementation of the right to immunity needs to be given clear and firm boundaries and reflects the existence of legal certainty and justice and how it is realized in Indonesia. In this case, the writer examines / conducts research using normative juridical research, which focuses more on library research, by advancing the theory of State Law, Law Enforcement Theory, Legal Protection and Legal Process When Advocates do not carry out their professional duties, they remain Advocates and must become role models for the legal community, given the honorable profession carried out by Advocates, but on the other hand immunity is not attached to Advocates if Advocates have committed criminal or civil law so that law enforcement officers can immediately carry out legal proceedings for Advocates.
