Narcotics crime has been transnational in nature which is carried out using a high modus operandi, advanced technology is supported by a wide network of organizations and caused many victims, especially among the young generation of nation which is very dangerous to peoples lives, nation and state so transnational countermeasures must also be taken. The problem raised as follows : (1). How is the bilateral cooperation between Indonesia and China in effort to prevent and eradicate crime of drug and illicit trafficking? (2). How do Indonesia and China overcome obstacles in the prevention and eradication of narcotics abuse and illicit trafficking?. This research is an empirical juridical research that uses primary file and secondary file.

This research approach is statute approach and conceptual approach. The results of the study indicate bilateral cooperation between Indonesia and China to prevent and eradicate crime of abuse and illicit trafficking of narcotics in the form of MoU ineffective, it is related to the substance of the MoU and which is only supervising. In effort to prevent and eradicate crime of abuse and illicit trafficking of narcotics there are obstacles to the existence of differences in legal rules governing narcotics such as prekursors. The form of cooperation is only in the form of MoU so it does not guarantee binding legal certainly to be obeyed and also limited by the legal sovereignty of each country which must respect each other. The strategy to overcome obstacles made through increasing multilateral cooperation also includes various other countries, especially those located in the Golden Triangle. Suggestion : Strengthening and enhancing more effective legal means in the context of international cooperation in eradicating transnational crime organizations in the trafficking of narcotics and psychotropic drugs.
